



I love the winter landscape in Winona—the white expanse of the frozen river, the muted brown of the trees on the bluffs, the cold clear air. A hundred years ago, without television and video, without even bright photos in magazines and shop windows, winter must have been time of little color. Imagine what it was like to step into Merchant’s Bank the day it opened in 1912 and experience what must have felt like a riot of color in the beautiful Tiffany windows. Four years later, Winona National Bank followed with its own windows.

Bits of colored glass are not required to run a profitable bank. Banks need paper, pencils, adding machines, vaults - the daily activity of a bank is adding numbers and keeping records, but the business of a bank is people. For more than 100 years, Winona has known that art has value to us as people, that the opportunity to experience awe matters, and that the possibility for art to make us stop for a moment and see the world in a different way is part of what makes us human. When we participate in those moments together, we become a community.

Now that the bluffs are green again (and after last winter, who isn’t glad to finally see that?), it is time to gather and begin the second decade of the Great River Shakespeare Festival.

This season, our plays ask profound questions. *Hamlet* challenges us to question the very meaning of our lives and poses perhaps the most basic dilemma of them all: to be or not to be. *The Merry Wives of Windsor* looks at life when we are “merry” (which means content or at ease). Where most plays look at a world in turmoil, *Merry Wives* explores what happens when we are at peace. And *Rosencrantz and Guildenstern are Dead* lands right in the middle. What happens when we are minor characters in our own story? How do we find joy, and how do we find meaning? As Rosencrantz puts it: “It’s all questions.”

I hope you leave the theater with questions. Questions lead to conversations, and the conversations deepen the ties between us, allow us to understand each other and ourselves a little better, and, yes, bring a little color to summer in Winona.

Polonius now serves as Lord Chamberlain to Claudius.

Hamlet comes from his school in Wittenberg and Laertes comes from Paris for the funeral/coronation/marriage.

Bernardo, Francisco, and Marcellus, night watchmen, have seen an apparition hunting the battlements in the form of King Hamlet.

GLOSSARY:

Melancholy	Elizabethans believed that a state of melancholy was brought on by a chemical imbalance in the human body.
Incest	Although against Elizabethan law, the marriage of Claudius and Gertrude would have been accepted in the dire circumstances of the king’s death, Hamlet being at away at school, and the threat of war with Norway.
Elizabethan Ghostlore	Elizabethan Protestants did not believe in purgatory, so a ghost was assumed to be a demon in disguise come back to tempt the living into damnation.

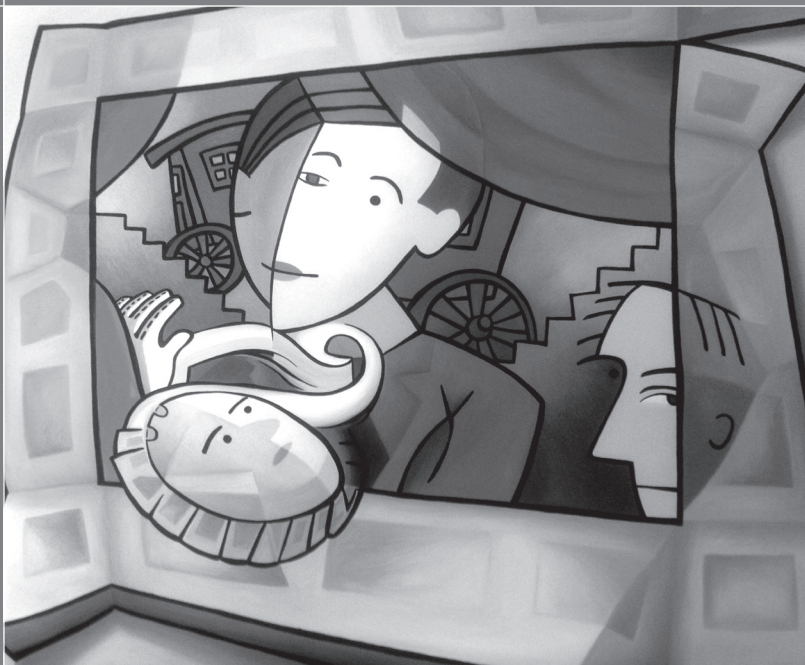

What would you do if every time you flip a coin it comes up heads; you doubt the direction of the sun; and you can't remember anything before breakfast this morning?

Syllogism, n:	An argument expressed in two propositions that contain a common term and a third proposition that results necessarily from the other two; e.g. All men are mortal. Socrates is a man. Socrates is mortal.
Dumbshow, n:	A part of a play acted in mime to summarize, supplement, or comment on the main action.

Educational programming is not just something GRSF does in addition to the shows; it is built into the very structure of our season. Indeed, education is a core value of GRSF's mission. These plays are for everyone. We are committed to doing whatever it takes to help others discover the joy and the reward of meeting a complex work of art head on. To you who are already on board, we hope to deepen your experience of the plays.

SHAKESPEARE IN THE SCHOOLS RESIDENCY In late winter, GRSF Acting Company teachers worked with students at Winona High School and Cotter High School to explore Shakespeare's Julius Caesar. Generously sponsored by Laurie Lucas, the Laird Norton Family Foundation, and the Southeast Minnesota Arts Council, the residencies give students a chance to experience Shakespeare with professional artists right in their schools.

SHAKESPEARE FOR YOUNG ACTORS AND DESIGNERS Visit us on Sunday, July 27th at 7:00pm to celebrate the work of our Shakespeare for Young Actors and Designers students in a performance of *The Tempest* and a portfolio showcase.
